

# DOES YOUR FOREST GROW HIGH-QUALITY TIMBER?

## A new device is now available for pruning -

# KARSIJA.

\* Karsija is a Finnish word meaning pruner.

**A distinct Karsija feature is the cutting motion directed around the branch, during which the cutting jaws close.**

The final wood material that carries the branch will remain in the centre of the branch, avoiding tearing from occurring. A potential breakpoint would be far from the bark of the stem wood. The cut finish is neat as if carved.

Only one approximately 11 cm light tug is sufficient per branch. The Karsija does not have a pulley, so both hands are working in the same direction the entire time. If necessary, body weight can be used to help.

Karsija is easy to use. When placing the device to the stem of the branch, a simple guide directs the cutting jaws onto the branch, as if dropped there.

When using the Karsija for pruning, everyone is a professional after a short learning period. Karsija creates a clean finish, regardless of its user. The Karsija is easily placed at the root of the branch stem. When using the device, one easily learns to hold the even side of the Karsija against

the tree. During the pull, the device is then slightly pressed against the tree.

The Karsija does not have extremities that could potentially damage the trunk of the tree during use. All functional parts are directed away from the tree trunk or paralleling it. Rarely can the bark of the tree be damaged so that a sap pocket is created.

Due to the spring at the base of the device, Karsija allows changes in the direction of the motion, in addition to the light pressing against the trunk.

When pruning the tree, it can be circled either clock or counterclockwise. When possible due to the branches, the pruning can also be started from the top, during which the Karsija will seem to drop to the next branch after the cut. In this case, it is best to circle the tree counterclockwise.

Work efficiency is several times greater than with the use of branch saws.

- Karsija 50, Sandvik/Bahco adaptor with plastic sleeve

\* the model number indicates the diameter of the branch that fits into the cutting jaws.

The weight of the device is approximately 670 grams without the stem.

A pruning guide is delivered with the device, where all practicalities regarding pruning and the Karsija are included. It can be used by everyone to form their unique perspective on pruning that is to be completed branch by branch. Patent FI 117 687
